97/12/14 Apologies Cllr A Yeomans

98/12/14 Chairman's Opening address:

Chairman reported on the Christmas tree lighting ceremony which went well and he thanked all who were involved. The budget for the ceremony had been set at £50. A slight overspend of £5 was approved by the Councillors.

99/12/14 Minutes

The notes were accepted as a true and accurate record and proposed by Cllr G Bailey and seconded by Cllr G Everard.

100/12/14 Declarations of Interest

Cllr J Dring declared an interest in item 8 on the agenda.

101/12/14 Feedback on action points;

- Street lighting- clerk had actioned and most were now working. Email response from LCC said that a two week fix time was normal.
- LRSP- the Chairman informed the meeting that the signs had arrived-4x 30 mph and 2 x40mph. The passive signs had been approved and the locations agreed. Battery life is apparently seven days.

102/12/14 Planning applications

Re-submission from Mr and Mrs Needham for The Vacherie. The Parish Council had no objections.

103/12/14 Financial report

The clerk presented the financial summary and circulated a copy to the councillors (copy attached to the minutes). The balance of the Lloyds account after all cheques had cleared (exception of the Christmas tree ceremony) was £1 841.45.

Cheques signed for the Church noticeboard £660 and also for the cost of the Christmas tree lighting ceremony.

104/12/14 Request for donation form Mother and Toddlers

Cllr J Dring had a request from the group for a possible donation from the Parish Council towards new equipment. After a discussion the Chairman proposed a donation of £300. This was seconded by Cllr G Bailey.

105/12/14 Request from CAB

Clerk informed the meeting that she had received a request from the CAB for a donation. After discussion it was decided to donate £50 as in previous years. This was proposed by Cllr J Dring and seconded by Cllr G Pout.

106/12/14 CCTV for Village Hall

Cllr G Panton reported that the Village Hall had received three quotes. The quote which they had accepted was for £2,080. Cllr Panton asked the Council to consider funding half the cost. After discussing the issue, the Chairman proposed that the Council donate £1,080. This was seconded by Cllr R Wright.

- The clerk informed the meeting of precept changes which need to be considered at the next meeting.

108/12/14 Issues from the Public Forum

- Cllr G Panton and the Chairman laid the Poppy wreath for Remembrance Sunday.
- Cllr G Everard asked the Chairman about the Cluster newsletter and the Chairman responded by informing the meeting that costings were still being done.
- The Chairman attended the Parish Plan meeting and was able to express North Kyme's view to some extent. The Chairman asked if anyone else would be interested in attending-open to all residents.
- District Councillors had no news but District Councillor Powell did point the Councillors to a web site called Fixmystreet.com
- The Chairman thanked all for their support.
