81/11/14 Apologies None

82/11/14 Chairman's Opening address:

The Chairman welcomed all to the meeting and introduced Mr G Everard as our new Councillor. Mr S Padley and Mr G Padley were also introduced to the Council.

83/11/14 Minutes

The notes were accepted as a true and accurate record and proposed by Cllr G Bailey and seconded by Cllr R Wright

85/11/14 Presentation from Mr G Padley

The Chairman invited Mr G Padley to speak to the Council. Mr Padley outlined a proposal to site storage containers on part of an 11 acre site behind Pocklington's yard. NKDC have been contacted and their opinion sought on the feasibility of such a plan. The land in question is not suitable for agricultural use and therefore an alternative use is being looked at, hence this proposal. The storage containers would be on one level so not visible.

Cllr Yeomans asked about the acreage which would be used-approximately 3 acres to be used. The use would be restricted to small business and domestic use.

Cllr Panton asked about access-concrete access of the A153 but not through Pocklington's yard.

The Chairman thanked Mr Padley for his presentation and re-iterated that the biggest concern would be illegal activities. Mr Padley gave assurances that the correct paperwork would be completed by all occupants.

86/11/14 Feedback on action points

Fly tipping-issue resolved

PCSO Sarah Kennedy reported that a distraction burglary had taken place on Main Street North Kyme. Residents need to be aware. Also this is the time of year when oil and diesel thefts increase so again, residents need to be aware of any unusual activity or strangers.

Cllr Yeomans raised the issue of a man who had been calling in the evening, reporting to be from the British Heart Foundation. PCSO has had no reports regarding this.

88/11/14 Financial report

The clerk reported that as of the 7th October was £2,780.67. Invoices presented for approval;

The Councillors discussed any other groups in the village which needed funding and Cllr Panton asked if Mother and Toddlers needed anything. Cllr J Dring to present a request at the next meeting.

89/11/14 Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership information on Speed Indicator Device-information received regarding speed sign -Chairman to update on progress.

Chairman explained that the LRSP had given the SID for free which would be shared with North Kyme. An invoice for £48 needed to be approved; this is the fee for inspection. Proposed by Cllr R Wright and seconded by Cllr A Yeomans.

Chairman explained his view regarding the tree-the one behind the bench will be used; Chairman feels it will be a talking point. A budget of £50.00 was proposed for the Christmas events by the Chairman and this was seconded by Cllr G Panton. The lighting of the tree will take place on Saturday 6th December at 5.00 p.m. the Chairman and Cllr Panton will arrange the Carols.

91/11/14 Donation request from St Luke's

The clerk read out a request from the Reverend Rose for a donation/funding of a new Church noticeboard for St Luke's. The proposed cost is £550 + vat. The Chairman proposed a donation of £660 which was agreed by all Councillors.

92/11/14 Cluster meeting

Stephen Priestley from NKDC spoke about the Local Plan and how this would impact on NKDC. This was followed by two representatives from Billingham PC who discussed the Neighbourhood plan. Billingham were keen for North Kyme to attend the next meeting and the Chairman volunteered to go along.

The Chairman also informed the meeting that he had suggested a Cluster magazine be produced, rather than separate issues of Parish newsletters.

It had also been agreed that each Parish interested in keeping the SID should contribute £31.00.
