2/05/18 Chairman's Opening Address:

5/05/18 Feedback on Action points.

- Phone box & Defibrillator - Cllr Pout had been in touch with Christian Slingsby of SHOCK Sleaford Co-ordinator for Sleaford & District Round Table who informed that he could supply a defibrillator and cabinet for £1000 as supplied by EMAS. Cllr Pout to enquire if this includes fitting and details of maintenance. * Agenda item: vote on purchase

- Dog Fouling Bins – *The Clerk to check if these have been ordered.
- Hill Holt Wood – Nothing to report
