The Chairman welcomed all to the meeting and thanked Glen Everard for completing the minutes for the March meeting.

113/04/18 Feedback on action points

- **Adoption of phone box**-clerk informed the meeting that the phone box was now the responsibility of the Parish Council. Discussion amongst Councillors as to what the use the phone box could be put to. The original idea was to use the box as a site for a Defibrillator. **Action:** The Chairman would approach a contact at the Rotary Club with regard to funding. Cllr Panton would also investigate providers as he was looking into putting a Defibrillator in the Village Hall.
- **Play Area**-Cllr Everard has ordered all the necessary equipment and the cost of this was £2850 + vat. A discussion amongst Councillors followed regarding the future extension of the Play Area. **Action: agenda item for the next meeting.**
- **Dog Fouling**- a lengthy discussion ensued about the need for an extra dog bin on Vacherie Lane. **Action:** clerk to order a 60 litre and 40 litre dog bin. The Chairman will erect a sign on the field warning dog owners of a possible £1,000 fine if they allow their dogs to foul the playing field.
- **Hill Holt Wood**- the Chairman reported that this was ongoing. **Action:** agenda item for the next meeting.

119/04/18 Items from the Public Forum

- Cllr Yeomans asked about CCTV cameras on the Village Playing field to identify those dog owners who are allowing their pets to foul the area. A discussion followed about Data Protection issues and how successful the cameras were for members of the Council to identify possible culprits. The Chairman will put signs warning the public that CCTV cameras are in use.
- Cllr Everard had received a complaint from a parishioner regarding parking on a public footpath. Agreed to monitor as it appeared that this issue has now been resolved.
- Cllr Everard asked about the repairs to the beacon. The Chairman will action.
- Cllr Yeomans raised the issue of members of the public dumping unwanted electrical items on the verges. This has caused a problem with scrap men. District Councillor Ogden informed the meeting that NKDC did run a collection scheme and items did need to be left on the verge for collection. If unsure, concerned residents could ring the council to check.
- Cllr Dring raised the poor state of the A153 and the pot holes which were appearing at an alarming rate. This has been raised by County Councillor Barry Young. A matter of waiting for Highways to deal with it.
