### **01/27: Chairman's Opening Address:**

PC Derek Daniels has been requested to attend this meeting.

### **Open Forum:**

The Chairman has spoken to the family of Bill Miller, who are also keen on having a memorial placed in church, but this will need a faculty from Lincoln diocese for a plaque or an inscribed table..

Reported to PC Daniels: Axle from a vehicle was projected into Mr Armitage's garden, this is not the first incident of items from passing vehicles being found. The Chairman has volunteered to go and see Mr Armitage.

PC Daniels suggested that the Parish Council contact Brian Burns (Lincs Road Safety Partnership). Regarding the speeding traffic problem through the village and try to arrange a site meeting with him.

Vandalism to the outside of the village hall, however the young people who attend Teen Scene went out and removed the graffiti, Cllr Dring reported. Mr J Goddard has offered to place a blackboard on the shed wall so as the youngsters can use it as a message board.

The matter of the lack of repeater signs and the 40mph extension to the B1395 was discussed. Contact K Smith (highways) regarding the 40mph repeater regulations, and to see if the extension cannot be extended past the educational establishment on Ferry Lane.
